- The Umpire's decision is final
- Sledging of or by players, umpires and spectators is not appropriate
- Captains ought to be clapped by opposing team when they take strike
- Players should respect each other at all times (your team and the opposite team)
- Players are to accept the umpire's decision
- Players should take pride in being part of a team and be proud to wear the team uniform
- Players and Umpires are to wear correct uniform (shirts and shorts/skirts) at all times
- Players should shake opponents' hands at completion of play
- Umpires will take care to make the best decision possible at all times
- Teams should do "3 cheers" at commencement of first fielding innings
- Teams will walk/run onto the field in a straight line and/or orderly fashion
- Team members should not stand in the middle of pitch after the fall of a wicket
- Teams should do "3 cheers" at completion of game for opposing team, umpires and scorers
- Teams should clap opposing team on and off field at change of innings
- Club Delegates inform their club members of any changes / updates to IVA rules/policies/events etc.
